

Prof. Giovanna Vittori



Giovanna Vittori graduated in Mathematics at the University of Genoa in 1986. In 1990 she obtained the PhD in Hydrodynamics (Network of Universities: University of Padua, Genoa, Florence and Trento). In 1989 Giovanna Vittori was awarded the 1st prize Post-graduate Student Competition – XXIII Int. Ass. Res. Conference, Ottawa, CANADA. From 1993 to 2000 she served as Senior Researcher at the University of Genoa and in 1992 she was awarded the international prize "Arturo Parisatti" for studies on the chaotic nature of tidal oscillations inside Venice Lagoon. She became full Professor of Hydraulics at the University of Genoa in 2000. Presently she is Coordinator of the PhD program in Civil, Chemical and Environmental Engineering. She is author of more than 120 papers published in journals and proceedings of international conferences. Her scientific interests are hydrodynamic stability, turbulence, sediment transport, coastal hydrodynamics and morpho dynamics.
