Coastal Engineering is a discipline of great importance in Italy, a giant pier surrounded by the sea in a strategic position in the middle of the Mediterranean Sea, with some 8000 km of coastline and about 3000 years of experience and achievements in coastal and harbour engineering from the Romans to Leonardo da Vinci and many others, (as also described in the specific chapter of the ASCE book "History and Heritage of Coastal Engineering" ed. In fact, Italy was successfully hosting its first ICCE in Venice in 1992. The renowned large scale project MOSE with mobile gates for the protection of the lagoon from high waters is now completed and will be in operation at the time of the conference in 2024, with the possibility to visit it within a post-conference tour.

Other significant coastal and port projects are underway (e.g., offshore gas terminals, wave energy converters, the new deep-water breakwater at Genoa).

The Italian community of Coastal Engineering is large and active, also in research, as shown by the quality and number of paper submissions at ICCE22 in Sydney.

The event management of the Conference will be done through a highly regarded professional conference organizer, who is also willing to assume the entrepreneurial risk associated to the event.

Italy is a safe country and its people have a reputation for friendliness and hospitality, especially in Rome, which is one of the most attractive cities in the world with millions of visitors each year.

Created in 2000, the Coasts, Oceans, Ports, and Rivers Institute (COPRI) is a semi-autonomous institute of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), the country's oldest national engineering society. The first ICCE was held in Long Beach, CA in 1950, and has been held biennially since. Although the conferences began with a national focus, they quickly became international in scope.



Largo Angelicum, 1 - Rome


