Piero Ruol has more than 40 years of experience in Coastal, Maritime and Hydraulic Engineering and holds technical and managerial positions within Padova University (Italy). He graduated in Civil Engineering in 1981 at the University of Padova, and achieved his Ph.D. in 1989 (Hydrodynamics). Since 2008 he is Full Professor at the Department of Civil, Environmental and Architectural Engineering (ICEA), teaching the courses of “Maritime Structures” and “Coastal Management and Protection”. He was head of the Department of Hydraulic, Maritime, Environmental and Geotechnical Engineering - IMAGE in the period 2008-2011. He was member of Commission to draw up the New Statue of Padova University and was Pro-Rector for European Funding for Research in the period 2012-2015. He was member of the Consultation Board for Societal Challenge SC3: ‘Secure, clean and efficient energy’ in Horizon 2020. He is Member of the Higher Council for Public Works - Technical advisory body of the State for the three-year period 2020-2023. He is author of more than 130 papers mainly published in international journals and international conferences. His recent research activity deals with maritime hydraulics, maritime and port engineering, innovative coastal protection interventions and wave energy studies.
